## THE NEED IS REAL

- According to the 2004 Census Bureau American Community Survey 800,027 Arizona's live at or below the Federal poverty level.
- Arizona's poverty rate is higher than the national average- 14.2 percent or one in every seven people.
- 312,966 Arizona children (one in five ) live in poverty.
- Of those Arizonans 65 years and older, 7.5 percent live in poverty.
- 686,378 are considered food insecure: they do not know where their next meal will come from.

- The poverty guideline for a family of four is an annual income of \$19,350.
- More than 574,000 low-income children in Arizona participate in the National School Lunch Program, which provides free and reduced-price lunches.
